FROM OUR KITCHENS



GRAHAM CRACKER CAKE

Submitted by Pam Crawford

1/2 # butter, melted
2 cups white sugar
1# box of Graham Cracker crumbs
1 cup milk
5 eggs
2 tsp. Baking powder
1 cup coconut
1 cup chopped pecans
1 tsp. Vanilla

Cream sugar and butter, beat until smooth. Add eggs, one at time, beating after each addition. Add crumbs and milk alternately. Put vanilla in milk. Add coconut and nuts. Bake in three 9 inch floured pans at 325 degrees for 30 minutes or until done in center.

Cool

Pineapple icing:

1 cup milk

1 stick butter

21/2 cups sugar

1 #2 can crushed pineapple, well drained

11/2 cups coconut

2 tsp. Vanilla

Cook all but vanilla until thick. Add vanilla when cool. Pour over layers. Let it ooze down sides.

This recipe I have made for 50 years and was given to me by Virginia Green.
